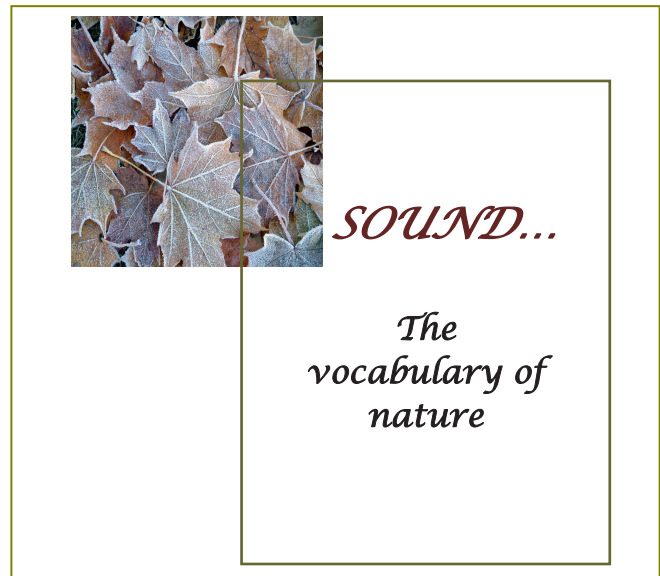

- Have you ever wondered why the government doesn't provide at least some help toward the purchase of hearing aids?
- Did you know that you can help make a hearing aid tax credit a reality?

of a hearing aid, which would mean a credit of \$1000 for two hearing aids. This credit would be available to adults and parents of dependent hearing-impaired children. The house version of the bill limits adults to 55 years and older and has a qualifying income cap of \$200,000.00 or less.

How can you make a difference? Take a few minutes to visit [www.hearingaidtaxcredit.org](http://www.hearingaidtaxcredit.org) and learn more about this truly needed legislation. Be sure to write your legislators so you can let them know just how important the hearing aid tax credit bill is to you- this option is even included on the website!

The Hearing Aid Tax Credit Bill was originally introduced in Congress in 2002, but never passed. This bill was reintroduced in May of this year. If this bill does eventually pass, it will provide for a \$500.00 tax credit every 5 years for the purchase
