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## Hearing Aid Policies and Procedures

### Hearing Testing:

- A hearing test performed by an audiologist within the past 6 months is required for any hearing aid evaluation.

### Medical Clearance:

- It is in your best interest to obtain medical clearance to wear a hearing aid. This clearance preferably comes from an otolaryngologist, but can also come from a family doctor. If you choose not to seek a medical evaluation you must sign a waiver to that effect.

### Hearing Aid Evaluation (HAE):

- At the hearing aid evaluation, the audiologist will discuss your hearing loss with you as well as your options regarding amplification. We will discuss the differences between different types of technology and the styles available.

- Hearing aid prices range from \$900.00 - \$3000.00 each.

- Almost all hearing aids are custom made, so if you decide to proceed with amplification, impressions will be taken of your ears. A "pre-sale contract" detailing what will be ordered and the costs involved will be completed and signed.

- It generally takes two weeks for hearing aids to come in. At that time, we will contact you to set up your hearing aid fitting.

### Hearing Aid Fitting (HAF):

- The hearing aid fitting takes approximately one hour. The audiologist will program the hearing aids, show you how to wear them, and evaluate the fitting. You will discuss use and care of the hearing aids as well as what to expect.

- A sale contract will be completed and signed.

- Payment in full is due on the day of the HAF.

- In addition to the cost of the hearing aids, a non-refundable \$125 fitting fee will be charged.

### 45-Day Trial Period:

- The day of your fitting begins your 45-day trial period. During that time you are encouraged to wear the hearing aids daily and in as many different situations as possible.

- Your audiologist will monitor your progress throughout the trial period through telephone calls and/or follow-up visits.
